President*- Leads the PTA towards specific goals chosen by the membership, works closely with the Principal, creates agendas for and presides at the Executive Board and General meetings and works with the treasurer and executive board on developing and implementing the budget.

Executive Vice-President - Oversees events and activities, partners with the President in fulfilling duties, performs duties of the President in their absence, oversees events and activities by working closely with event chairman and oversees the organization and implementation of volunteers.

Secretary* - Keeps and prepares minutes of all meetings.

Auditor* - Audits the books annually

Fundraising Coordinator - Coordinates all major school fundraisers and makes a report to the membership after each event.

Membership Coordinator - Create a membership drive, coordinate membership in the fall, set up a booth at Open House and maintain records of members.

Treasurer*- Keeps financial books in order, receives all cash and other income and makes bank deposits, pays any bills and member reimbursements, remits PTA membership dues and other fees to the PTA council, makes a monthly financial report, works closely with the President and other event chairs and prepares books for annual audit.
